#### 3) To report:

- Projected *Revenue* variance primarily due to:
  - Swimmer Fees → \$10 K positive swing in the variance is due to the following amounts not previously included in the forecast: \$7K precomp; \$2K AWG, \$1K of converts to semi comp. Good news!
  - Bingos → Haven't included December payout as Credits have not been paid out to families
    yet. December's payout was considerably higher than July Nov payouts, so more good
    news.
- Projected Expenses variance primarily due to:
  - o **Program Development** → Seton and Remington Pool Costs
  - Clothing Expenses → possibility Vivos clothing costs may come in higher than expected (will report this next board meeting)
  - PreComp Expenses → Purchase of supplies in advance
- Projected Optional Fundraising variance due to:
  - o miscellaneous unplanned revenues from Purdy's kickback, towel fundraiser, Balzac, grocery cards, and bottle drive.

## 8. Recruitment Update – Jason Spratt

Pre-comp numbers are down. What are we going to do about it?

- Having money allocated for marketing and advertising is an issue for recruitment. Signs are approximately \$300 for 2 weeks.
- Jason has been talking about doing a cash calendar. He is prepared to have it ready by the end of February with a sales blitz in March with a payout in April and a second sales blitz in May with a payout in June.
  - We can solicit parents in pre-comp programs to support
  - o It will get us into communities where we are trying to build our base
  - o The calendar will provide multiple advantages recruitment, marketing, fundraising
  - o Can some of the funds raised in the Cash Calendar be directed to recruitment
  - Jason requires seed money to begin and then provide Jason with the profits earned from to keep it going
  - Helen moves that we put \$500 in a new budget line from the projected revenue from the Flames 50/50 for recruitment. Amanda seconds. Motion carried.
- Jason has also been looking into creating a data base. The database comes with a cost of approximately \$240 / year.
